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❖ **2008 Vintage**

- Gold Medal - **2010 BORDEAUX WINE AWARDS**
- Bronze Medal - **2010 DECANTER WORLD WINE AWARDS**
- 88/100 - Beautiful intense, vibrant red. Spruce nose of red fruits coupled with a floral tone. On the palate, lovely framework, a full wine with fruit expression to the fore. Savoury, long-lasting finish, quite oaky yet not overblown - **2012 GILBERT & GAILLARD GUIDE**
- 87/100 - A lighter-bodied style, with herb, pomegranate, mulled cherry and mineral notes that move briskly through the finish. Drink now - **WINE SPECTATOR 2011**
- 15.5/20 - **2012 WINE AND BUSINESS CLUB GUIDE**
- An aromatic freshness with hints of wonderful earthy and mineral notes on the nose. Generous fruit, ripe plum, ripe berries and always this great minerality, notes of truffle and damp earth. On the palate one perceives the ripe fruit, and crisp berries, there is very little oak, yet nice soft tannins and a great freshness. The wine is pretty long and keeps lingering for a while, and it has a fresh aftertaste - **ANDREAS LARSSON, 2007 BEST SOMMELIER OF THE WORLD**

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### ❖ 2009 Vintage

- Silver Medal - **2011 BRUSSELS WINE COMPETITION**
- 89/100 - Intense colour. Nose of late-picked black berry fruits, notes of liquorice and roasted oak. The palate is very dense with emphasis on power and concentration. Still tightly-wound, likely holds a surprise or two in store - **2013 GILBERT & GAILLARD GUIDE**
- 88/100 - Taut, with damson plum, cherry skin and blueberry paste notes carried by a sinewy structure. Lightly firm toast holds sway on the finish. Drink now - **WINE SPECTATOR 2011**
- 16/20 - **2012 WINE AND BUSINESS CLUB GUIDE**
- 14.5/20 - Graphite notes underline this merlot (90%) characterized by a mellow structure and refined ageing - **2012 RED GUIDE OF THE FRENCH WINE REVIEW "BEST WINES UNDER 20 EUROS"**
- In 2006 Franck Moureau left his career of journalist to take over this 18 ha property, his sister joins him in 2009. This pair offers here a wine of sterling, ruby colour, with an open and pleasant nose, floral, fruity and spicy, invigorated by a mineral touch. ### ❖ 2010 Vintage

- Silver Medal - **2012 BRUSSELS WINE COMPETITION**
- 88/100 - Deeply-coloured with crimson highlights. Nose of red fruits entwined with violet accents. On the palate, a more exotic style suggestive of vanilla and eucalyptus. Lovely fleshy wine with stuffing, balance yet also a measure of persistency - **2013 GILBERT & GAILLARD GUIDE**

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
